

# Data Protection Act 2018

Duration: 1 day

The DPA (Data Protection Act) 2018 came into effect on 25 May 2018. It incorporates the GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation) into UK law and replaces the DPA 1998. This course provides you with an overview of the differences between the GDPR and the DPA 2018.

## QUALIFICATION:

## COURSE OVERVIEW

This course provides a comprehensive introduction to the DPA 2018 and covers the similarities and differences between the DPA 2018 and the GDPR.

The UK invoked Article 50 on 29 March 2017, meaning the UK is scheduled to leave the EU. As the GDPR is a European regulation, many are questioning what this means in relation to Brexit.

This course covers the DPA 2018 and the GDPR; and how the Brexit draft regulations, or a no deal Brexit, will affect data protection in your organisation.

- Describe the rights and obligations of the Information Commissioner.
- What implications the Brexit draft regulations or a no deal Brexit will have on data protection.
