This includes their responsibility in preventing an outbreak of fire, as required by The Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005. This legislation states that you 'must ensure that your employees are provided with adequate fire safety training.

- Do you have an evacuation plan?
- Do you have regular fire drills at random times of the day?
