Taken as either a five-day option combining both Foundation and Practitioner examinations or individually as a three-day Foundation and a three-day Practitioner Conversion, these accredited courses have been designed to provide delegates with the skills to understand the PRINCE2 methodology and its practical application.

IS IT RIGHT FOR ME?

Suitable for people requiring a solid grounding in the PRINCE2 project management methodology, and who do not require the depth of the Practitioner programme. To make the most of the course, delegates should ideally have some experience of basic project management principles. Typical delegates are new project managers or have been working in a project support role.

PRE-COURSE ACTIVITY

To prepare for this intensive course, a sound understanding of project management is required. To assist you with your preparation for the Foundation exam, Hemsley Fraser has devised a study plan. The course entails a significant amount of pre-course work and evening work during the course.
